

Criterion and guidelines for the SESI National Shoulder Observership

Mandatory criterion

1. Applicant should be the member of SESI
2. Age < 45 years
3. Minimum 2 years after postgraduation
4. Applicant must have attended at least one SESI conference/IAS (certificate is required)
5. Applicant must possess minimum one year experience in shoulder surgeries
6. The application must be proposed by a SESI member along with his email and phone number.

Criterion for point allotment

1. Experience in orthopaedics (After 2 years of postgraduation):
 - a) 0-2 years: 2 points
 - b) 2-5 years: 4 points
 - c) 5-10 years: 6 points
 - d) >10 years: 2 points
2. Publications: Only in MCI relevant indexed journals (Pubmed, Scopus, Medline, Index Copernicus). Non-MCI indexed journals would be given no points.
 - Each Original article: 4 points
 - Each case report/review article: 1 point
 - Each chapter contribution in book: 1 point (Max. 3 points)

Please note: Points for publication will be allotted only if the applicant is first author, second author or author for correspondence.

3. Years in arthroscopy
 - a) 1-3 years: 2 point
 - b) 3-5 years: 4 point
 - c) >5 years: 6 point
4. Awards in orthopaedics by state/national/international level
 - a) State award: 2 point each (max 4 points)
 - b) National award: 4 point (max 8 points)
 - c) International award: 8 points (max 16 points)

Please Note: provide the certificate of award.

5. Past fellowship/observership experience: Yes/No. *If yes, provide a copy of certificate*
 - a) National: If attended, 2 points
 - b) International: If attended, 4 points
7. Attended cadaveric shoulder workshop in past: Yes/No. *If yes, provide a copy of certificate*
 - a) Course attended: 2 points
